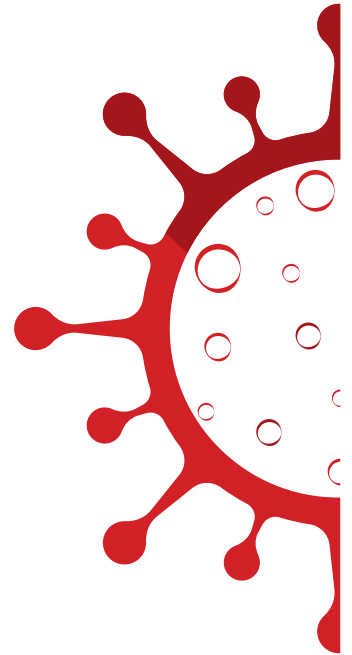
CREATIVE MOJO IS READY WHEN YOU ARE
FOR YOUR HOME TO GET IT'S MOJO BACK!

As you know our activities are crucial to the mental health and wellbeing of your residents and because of this your residents' health during the current Coronavirus outbreak is of utmost importance to us.

There are now a certain number of things that we are able to offer your home which we were not able to before. One of these is that we are now able to spend time outdoors, including private gardens and other outdoor spaces, in groups of up to six people from different households, following social distancing guidelines.

OUR INFECTION-CONTROL PRACTICE

It is acknowledged that care homes settings have policies already in place in relation to infection control and take account of COVID-19 and further to this, the representative for the Creative Mojo workshop will promote and facilitate our best infection-control practice, including the following:



1

Hand hygiene must be maintained through the workshop.

- The importance of frequent handwashing with soap and water (or using hand sanitizer where soap and water are not available) including:
 - When your workshop leader arrives at the setting and before they leave the setting;
 - Before and after using the toilet.



2

Limiting close contact with others as much as possible.

- All workshop leaders to keep to Government social distancing guidelines.
- All workshop leaders to avoid touching their face.



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3

Establish procedures to routinely clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces and objects.

(e.g. paint brushes, paint pots etc.).

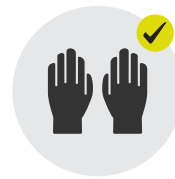
- Each resident will have their own brush and paint pallet or pots to use for their own use only. Strictly no sharing.
- Paint pots and supplies will not be shared with other care homes until thoroughly washed, disinfected and removed from use for at least 24 hours. No care home to care home cross contamination.

Wearing gloves and face masks throughout the session.

- Gloves and face masks must be worn at all times and can only be removed once the representative has left the premises. We are prepared to wear full visors and plastic aprons if so requested by the home.

Communicating with the home.

- This includes if we are sick, have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19, or if someone in the household has symptoms (cough, fever, shortness of breath).
- We also require feedback from care homes regarding any residents that may be unwell or showing suspected symptoms of Covid-19 for the welfare of our own representatives.



Remember, we also offer 1-2-1 workshops if this suits your home during this time. Larger groups can be split into smaller groups of three for half hour sessions, meaning social distancing can be maintained correctly.
